This height also reduces the risk of accidental contact with water or debris on the floor. 3. Environmental Considerations

- Choose a dry, well-ventilated location to prevent overheating and corrosion.
- Avoid areas with high humidity, dust, or chemical exposure.
- For outdoor or harsh environments, select boxes with IP66 or NEMA 4X ratings to ensure water and dust resistance . 4. Safety and Grounding
- Ensure the metal enclosure, internal electrical board, and appliances are properly grounded.
- Install leakage protectors and circuit breakers for additional safety
