

Methods for removing paint from fireproof cable trays



Article Overview

Paint can be removed from fireproof cable trays using mechanical, chemical, or thermal methods while ensuring the tray's fireproof integrity is preserved.

Mechanical Methods

Mechanical removal involves physically stripping the paint without compromising the tray's structure:

- Wire brushing or sanding: Use hand or power tools with wire brushes or sandpaper to remove loose or flaking paint. This is suitable for small areas or light coatings but may be labor-intensive for large trays .
- Abrasive blasting: Sandblasting or bead blasting can efficiently remove paint and rust, revealing a clean metallic surface. Care must be taken to control pressure to avoid damaging the tray's fireproof coating or underlying metal .

Chemical Methods

Chemical paint strippers dissolve paint for easier removal:

- Solvent-based strippers: Apply a paint remover compatible with metal surfaces. Ensure the product does not react with fireproof coatings or compromise flame resistance. Follow manufacturer safety guidelines, including ventilation and protective equipment
