Overview

The NEMA VE 2-2006 publication, developed by the National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) and approved by the Cable Tray Institute, serves as a practical guide for installing cable tray systems . It is intended for engineers, contractors, and maintenance personnel and emphasizes safe work practices in accordance with NFPA 70E. The standard does not replace local electrical codes but complements them by providing detailed installation and maintenance guidance .

Scope and Purpose

The standard addresses:

- Shipping and handling of cable trays to prevent damage during transport .
- Storage requirements to maintain tray integrity before installation .
- Installation procedures, including proper support, alignment, and securing of trays .
- Maintenance and system modifications, ensuring long-term reliability and safety .
- Safety warnings, such as prohibiting the use of cable trays as walkways or ladders, and highlighting the risk of hazardous voltages . The guidelines are designed to accommodate both metallic and nonmetallic cable tray systems and are periodically reviewed to reflect advances in technology and construction techniques
