A fiber optic patch cord is a short, flexible cable with connectors on both ends, used to interconnect network devices for high-speed optical data transmission.

What is a Fiber Optic Patch Cord?

A fiber optic patch cord (also called a fiber jumper or patch cable) is a fiber optic cable terminated with connectors at both ends, designed for short-distance, flexible connections within optical networks. It connects devices such as optical transceivers, switches, patch panels, servers, and cross-connect frames. Unlike backbone trunk cables, patch cords are dynamic and frequently handled, making proper selection critical to avoid signal loss or downtime .

Fiber Types

- Single-mode (SM, OS1/OS2): Core $\sim 9\mu\text{m}$, suitable for long-distance transmission (up to 100 km+), high bandwidth, used in telecom and data center interconnects .
- Multimode (MM: OM1/OM2/OM3/OM4/OM5): Core 50-62.5 μm , suitable for short to medium distances (up to 500 m), commonly used in intra-data center links .
- Bend-insensitive fibers (G.657A1/A2): Ideal for tight spaces and FTTH applications .
