Secondary distribution boxes typically have a service life of 15 to 30 years, which can extend to 50 years or more with proper maintenance and favorable conditions.

Typical Lifespan

The enclosure and busbars of secondary distribution boxes generally last 15–30 years, depending on the quality of materials, installation, and environmental conditions, while some well-maintained units can remain operational for 50 years or longer . Individual components, such as circuit breakers, have more limited lifespans, often rated for 10,000 mechanical operations or load cycles, after which they may need replacement .

Factors Affecting Service Life

- **Maintenance Practices:** Regular preventive and predictive maintenance, including visual inspections, functional testing, and condition monitoring, can significantly extend the lifespan of distribution boxes . Neglecting maintenance increases the risk of loose connections, overheating, and electrical failures .
- **Environmental Conditions:** Exposure to high humidity, dust, corrosive atmospheres, or extreme temperatures can accelerate aging of insulation and metal components .
- **Load and Usage:** Overloaded circuits or frequent switching operations can reduce the operational life of internal components like breakers and fuses .
- **Quality of Components:** Higher-quality materials and modern designs with arc-resistant features tend to last longer and require less frequent replacement
