Overview of the Three-Level Distribution System

A three-level distribution system distributes electrical power from the main supply to individual equipment through three hierarchical levels :

- **First-Level Distribution Box (Main Distribution Box):** Receives power from the source and distributes it to second-level boxes. It contains main circuit breakers, leakage protectors, voltmeters, and ammeters for centralized monitoring .
- **Second-Level Distribution Box:** Receives power from the first-level box and distributes it to third-level boxes. It typically contains branch circuit breakers and branch leakage protectors for each branch circuit .
- **Third-Level Distribution Box (Switch Box):** Located at the end of the distribution chain, it directly powers electrical equipment. It usually contains isolation switches, circuit breakers, and leakage protectors .
