An ODN (Optical Distribution Network) is the passive fiber infrastructure in FTTH networks, and a fiber distribution box is a key component that organizes, protects, and distributes optical fibers to end users.

What is an ODN?

An Optical Distribution Network (ODN) is the passive portion of a fiber-optic network that connects the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the central office to Optical Network Units (ONUs/ONTs) at subscriber premises without requiring electrical power . It forms the backbone of FTTH (Fiber-to-the-Home) systems, ensuring efficient, reliable, and cost-effective delivery of optical signals. The ODN typically includes:

- Feeder cables: High-capacity fibers from the OLT to local distribution points.
- Optical splitters: Devices that divide a single optical signal into multiple outputs for multiple users.
- Distribution cables: Fibers that carry split signals to neighborhoods or buildings.
- Drop cables: Final fiber links to individual homes or offices.
- Fiber distribution boxes (FDBs): Enclosures that manage, protect, and distribute fibers.
- Splice closures, connectors, and patch cords: Components that ensure secure connections and signal integrity .
