

Optical Module Assembly Scheme



Article Overview

An optical module assembly scheme integrates TOSA, ROSA, or BOSA sub-assemblies with a precision PCB and co-packaged optics to convert electrical signals to optical signals and vice versa, ensuring high-speed, low-loss data transmission.

Core Components of an Optical Module

1. Optical Sub-Assemblies (OSA)

- TOSA (Transmitting Optical Sub-Assembly): Converts electrical signals into optical signals using laser diodes (VCSEL, FP, or DFB) and couples light into fibers. Variants include DML TOSA (Direct Modulation Laser) and EML TOSA (Electro-Absorption Modulated Laser), with options for cooled or uncooled operation depending on temperature stability requirements .
 - ROSA (Receiving Optical Sub-Assembly): Converts incoming optical signals into electrical signals using photodetectors (PIN or APD), providing high sensitivity and efficient photoelectric conversion .
 - BOSA (Bi-Directional Optical Sub-Assembly): Combines TOSA and ROSA functions for single-fiber bidirectional communication, using different wavelengths for transmit and receive paths .
2. Printed Circuit Board (PCB) The PCB serves as both the electrical and mechanical foundation. It must handle extreme data rates (112-224 Gbps per lane or higher), manage thermal loads from dense components like DSPs and TIAs, and maintain sub-micron mechanical precision for optical alignment . Key considerations include:
