Overview of OLT Optical Modules

OLT (Optical Line Terminal) devices serve as the service provider endpoint in a Passive Optical Network (PON) and connect to multiple ONUs/ONTs. To interface with fiber networks, OLTs often use pluggable optical modules such as SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) and SFP+ modules. These modules handle the electro-optical conversion and support different transmission speeds and wavelengths depending on the PON technology .

Common Types of Optical Modules

- SFP Modules (1G)
 - Used for GPON and EPON networks.
 - Typically support 1.25 Gbps downstream and 1.25 Gbps upstream.
 - Suitable for small to medium-scale deployments and standard PON split ratios .
- SFP+ Modules (10G)
 - Used for XGS-PON, 10G-EPON, and high-speed GPON upgrades.
 - Support 10 Gbps downstream and 2.5-10 Gbps upstream depending on the standard.
 - Often deployed in rack-mounted or high-capacity OLTs for large-scale networks
