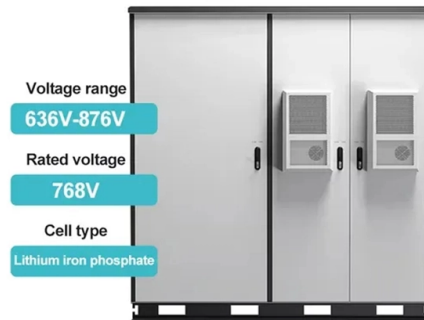

On the other hand, PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) splitters use integrated waveguide technology on a quartz substrate, which allows for precise and uniform splitting across many outputs. This technology is more complex and expensive to produce, especially for high-channel splitters like 1×16, 1×32, or 1×64. PLC splitters offer better performance in terms of insertion loss, wavelength uniformity, and environmental stability, making them ideal for dense PON networks, data centers, and large-scale deployments. In summary, while FBT splitters are inexpensive and suitable for small, low-ratio applications, PLC splitters are more costly but provide higher performance and reliability for larger, high-ratio networks. The choice between them depends on the network size, required split ratio, and budget considerations.
