The ISO 4217 currency code for the Bahamian dollar is BSD.

The Bahamian dollar (BSD) is the official currency of The Bahamas, introduced in 1966 to replace the Bahamian pound . It is pegged 1:1 to the US dollar, meaning one Bahamian dollar equals one US dollar, and both currencies are widely accepted across the islands . The currency is issued and regulated by the Central Bank of The Bahamas .

Currency Symbol and Subunits

The Bahamian dollar is commonly represented by (** or **B) to distinguish it from other dollar-denominated currencies . It is divided into 100 cents, with coins in denominations of 1, 5, 10, 15, 25, and 50 cents, and banknotes in 0.50, 1, 3, 5, 10, 20, 50, and 100-dollar denominations .

Digital Currency

In addition to physical cash, The Bahamas introduced the Sand Dollar in 2020, a legal digital version of the Bahamian dollar, which functions alongside traditional BSD notes and coins .

Practical Use
