

Pairing and using optical modules

Pairing optical modules requires verifying compatibility, cleaning connectors, handling components carefully, and properly installing the modules to ensure optimal signal performance.

1. Verify Compatibility

Before connecting optical modules, ensure that the module type, connector type, fiber mode, and wavelength match the intended network setup. Common connector types include LC, SC, ST, and MPO, and modules may be single-mode or multi-mode. For SFP modules, confirm the data rate (e.g., 10G SFP+) and wavelength (e.g., 850 nm for multimode, 1310 nm for single-mode) to prevent signal loss or degradation . BiDi modules require attention to Tx/Rx wavelength alignment for single-fiber bidirectional communication .

2. Prepare for Installation

- ESD Protection: Wear an anti-static wrist strap or use grounded tools to prevent damage to sensitive components .
- Cleaning: Use lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to clean both the optical module ports and fiber connectors. Inspect the end-faces with a fiber inspection scope to remove dust or debris that could cause attenuation or reflection .
- Inspect Cables: Check for frayed jackets, bent pins, or other physical damage. Testing with an OTDR can help identify optical loss points .
