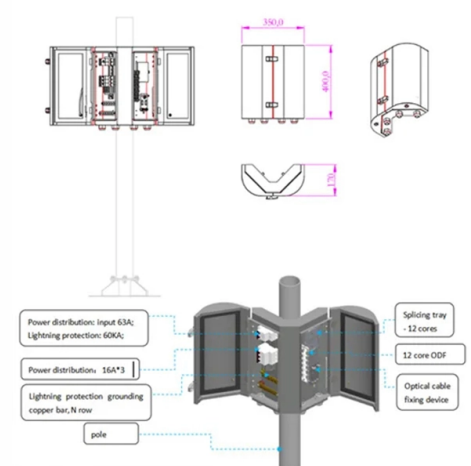


Pigtail and Interface Types

Pigtail interfaces are classified based on connector type, fiber type, polish type, and specialized design for environmental or application requirements.

Classification by Connector Type

Fiber optic pigtails are primarily categorized by the type of connector installed on the factory-terminated end:

- SC (Subscriber Connector): Push-pull design, widely used in telecom and data communications, suitable for single-mode and multimode fibers .
- LC (Lucent Connector): Compact size, ideal for high-density panels and data centers .
- FC (Ferrule Connector): Screw-threaded, provides strong vibration resistance, commonly used in measurement equipment and broadcasting systems .
- ST (Straight Tip): Bayonet-type lock, easy to install and remove, often used in multimode LAN applications .
- MU, MTRJ, MPO/MTP: Specialized connectors for high-density or multi-fiber applications.

Classification by Fiber Type

Pigtails are also classified according to the optical fiber they use:

- Single-mode fiber (SMF): Typically yellow, designed for long-distance transmission with low loss
