

PoE Powered Switch Wiring



Article Overview

A PoE switch delivers both data and power over Ethernet cables, using either Mode A (data pairs) or Mode B (spare pairs) wiring depending on the standard.

Understanding PoE Wiring

PoE (Power over Ethernet) allows a single Ethernet cable to carry both network data and electrical power to devices like IP cameras, VoIP phones, and wireless access points . The wiring depends on the PoE standard and the type of cable used:

- Cable Types: Cat5e, Cat6, or higher is recommended for PoE to ensure safe and efficient power delivery .
- Voltage and Power: Standard PoE delivers 44–57V DC, with power levels ranging from 15.4W (IEEE 802.3af) to 60W or more (Cisco UPOE or IEEE 802.3bt), .

Pinouts and Wiring Modes

Ethernet cables have 8 wires (4 pairs), numbered 1 through 8. PoE can deliver power in two main modes:

- Mode A (Alternative A): Power is sent over the same pairs used for data. For 10/100 Mbps Ethernet, this is typically pairs 1/2 and 3/6 .
- Mode B (Alternative B): Power is sent over the spare pairs not used for data, usually pairs 4/5 and 7/8 .
- Gigabit Ethernet (1000BASE-T): All four pairs carry data, so PoE uses a phantom power technique to superimpose DC voltage on the data pairs
