 - Equipment: Fiber coloring machine with pay-off, coloring mold, ink system, UV curing oven, traction, and take-up system.
 - Key Requirements: No color migration, neat fiber arrangement, and compliance with attenuation standards ().
- #### 2. Secondary Coating Process
- Purpose: Apply a protective loose tube via extrusion and fill with fiber-specific grease for long-term protection.
 - Equipment: Extrusion line with precise temperature and pressure control.
 - Outcome: Ensures fiber durability, flexibility, and protection against environmental stress ().
- #### 3. Cabling Process
- Purpose: Combine multiple coated fibers into a cable structure to enhance flexibility, tensile strength, and bending performance....
