

Pre-reserved openings for cable tray connections



Article Overview

Pre-reserved openings in cable trays are designed to facilitate safe, standardized connections and branching for electrical and instrumentation systems, ensuring compliance with NEC and other standards.

Purpose of Pre-Reserved Openings

Pre-reserved openings, also known as knock-outs or pre-cut holes, are incorporated into cable trays to allow for:

- Branching to equipment or devices without cutting the tray on-site.
- Routing cables through walls, floors, or other trays while maintaining structural integrity.
- Grounding and bonding connections in accordance with NEC Article 392 requirements . These openings help maintain proper cable spacing, minimize mechanical stress, and reduce installation time .

Types and Design Considerations

- Knock-out holes: Circular or rectangular perforations that can be removed as needed for cable entry or exit.
- Pre-drilled slots: Fixed-size slots for standard conduit or cable fittings.
- Connection brackets: Used in conjunction with openings to secure tray sections or branch connections; designs vary depending on load and application
