A primary distribution box power meter measures electrical consumption at the primary voltage level, using current and potential transformers to safely monitor high-voltage circuits before stepping down for customer use.

Overview

A primary distribution box (DB box) power meter is installed in high-voltage distribution systems to monitor and measure electrical energy delivered to large industrial or commercial customers. These customers often receive primary voltage service, meaning the electricity is supplied at high voltage and stepped down locally using their own transformers (). The primary meter ensures accurate billing and system monitoring.

Components and Function

- Current Transformers (CTs): Installed on each phase, CTs reduce high current to a measurable level for the meter, ensuring safety and accuracy ().
- Potential Transformers (PTs): PTs step down high voltage to a lower, measurable voltage for the meter ().
- Metering Enclosure: The DB box houses the CTs, PTs, and the meter itself, providing protection against electrical faults and environmental hazards ().
- Bus Bars and Circuit Breakers: These components distribute power safely to downstream circuits and protect against overloads or short circuits ().
- Smart Features: Modern DB boxes may include energy monitoring units, communication modules, and remote control capabilities for real-time data collection and energy management ()....
