RS485 signals are transmitted over fiber optic cables using either single-mode or multi-mode fiber with compatible RS485-to-fiber converters.

Overview

RS485 over fiber is used to extend serial communication over long distances while providing immunity to electrical interference and noise, which is common in industrial environments . The RS485 signal can be transmitted directly over fiber using level-type converters that preserve the original serial data format, or via protocol-type converters that encapsulate RS485 data into TCP/IP for networked applications .

Fiber Types

- Multi-mode fiber (MMF): Typically used for shorter distances, up to about 5 km (3 miles), and is cost-effective for industrial setups .
- Single-mode fiber (SMF): Suitable for long-distance transmission, up to 40 km (25 miles), ideal for connecting remote RS485 devices across large facilities or campuses .
