

Relay protection device reset



Article Overview

A reset function itself does not act as a protective device, but it interacts with safety or protective relays to restore the system to an operational state after a fault or emergency stop.

Safety Relay Reset

In safety systems, such as emergency stop circuits, the reset function is used to transition a safety relay from a safe state back to an operational state. This can be done either manually, via a dedicated pushbutton, or automatically, depending on the relay design. For example, the MSR138.1DP single-function safety relay supports both manual reset, where a pulse is applied to the reset terminal, and automatic reset, where the relay becomes ready once test inputs are satisfied. The reset input itself (e.g., terminal S34) does not provide protection; it merely allows the relay to resume operation after a protective action has occurred.

Protective Relays and Reset Factor

In power systems, protective relays monitor abnormal conditions such as overcurrent, short circuits, or voltage deviations. When a fault occurs, the relay trips the circuit to prevent damage. The reset factor of a protective relay refers to its ability to return to a ready state after a temporary fault has cleared, effectively reversing the trip decision if the fault is no longer present. This ensures the relay can respond quickly to subsequent events, but the reset function itself is not a protective device—it is part of the relay's operational cycle....
