

Removing the pigtail connector

Safety First

Before attempting to remove a pigtail connector, turn off the power to the circuit or disconnect the vehicle battery to prevent electrical shock or short circuits . Wear insulated gloves and safety goggles to protect yourself from sparks or accidental contact with live wires .

Tools You Will Need

- Wire cutters/strippers for trimming and preparing wires
- Screwdriver to loosen terminal screws
- Terminal removal tools or a mini screwdriver for depinning automotive connectors
- Electrical tape or heat shrink tubing for insulation after removal

1. Disconnect Power

Ensure the circuit is de-energized. In vehicles, disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent accidental shorts .
