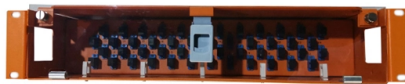


Requirements for Labeling Lighting Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

Lighting distribution boxes should be labeled according to UL 969, ANSI Z535, NFPA 70, and NEC requirements to ensure safety, clarity, and compliance.

Key Labeling Standards

UL 969: This is the primary standard for marking and labeling systems in the U.S., covering pressure-sensitive labels, nameplates, and markers. It specifies requirements for permanence, legibility, and durability under various conditions, including indoor/outdoor use, temperature extremes, and exposure to chemicals or oils. Labels must remain readable for the intended life of the equipment and adhere securely to the application surface . UL 969A: Focuses on flag labels, wrap-around labels, and related products, providing guidance for labeling components where standard flat labels are impractical . ANSI Z535.4: Provides guidelines for safety signs and labels, including signal words (e.g., DANGER, WARNING, CAUTION), color coding, and hazard communication. This standard is referenced in NEC Article 110.21 and NFPA 70E for electrical safety labeling . NFPA 70 / NEC:

- NEC Article 110.16 requires labeling of electrical equipment to warn personnel of potential hazards.
- NEC Article 110.21 specifies field-applied markings and signage for electrical panels.
- NFPA 70E Article 130.5 addresses labeling for arc flash hazards and PPE requirements
