

Requirements for Removing Overhead Optical Cables



Article Overview

Removing overhead optical cables requires careful planning, adherence to safety standards, proper tools, and compliance with industry regulations to prevent damage and ensure operational continuity.

Planning and Assessment

Before removing overhead optical cables, conduct a thorough inventory of all existing cables, identifying active and inactive lines, and create detailed maps of cable routes and connection points to avoid accidental disconnections (AmorServ) . Evaluate potential risks, including structural hazards, electrical interference, and accidental fiber damage, and develop mitigation plans such as backup systems or temporary rerouting.

Safety Measures

Personnel must use appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), including rubber gloves, leather gloves for climbing, safety harnesses, and eye protection to prevent injury from falls or laser exposure in active fibers (Corning) . Avoid stepping on cables or enclosures, and maintain safe distances from hardware under tension. Follow FOA guidelines for fiber optic safety, including protection from fiber scraps and eye hazards (FOA) .
