

Requirements for leaving openings in distribution boxes



Overview

Conductors must enter through approved openings and be protected from abrasion. Requirements include: Boxes must be equipped with covers unless they contain a device or luminaire canopy. Unused openings in boxes, raceways, auxiliary gutters, cabinets, equipment cases, or housings shall be effectively closed to afford protection substantially equivalent to the wall of the equipment.
