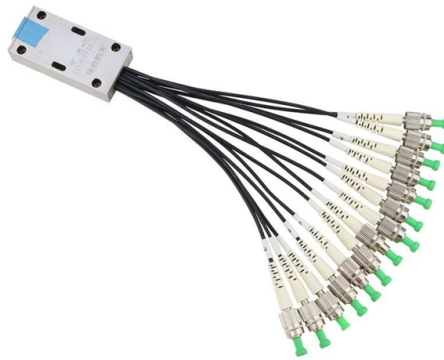

These modules allow a single optical fiber to be split into multiple endpoints using passive optical splitters, meaning no active electrical components are required between the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the central office and the Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at user premises . This architecture reduces maintenance costs, improves reliability, and supports scalable broadband delivery.

- **Data Rates:** GPON SFPs typically support 2.5 Gbps downstream and 1.25 Gbps upstream, sufficient for high-speed internet, IPTV, VoIP, and enterprise networking .
- **Distance Coverage:** Standard GPON SFPs can cover up to 20 km between the OLT and end-user devices, making them suitable for both urban and rural deployments .
- **Compatibility:** These modules conform to industry Multi-Source Agreements (MSAs), ensuring interoperability with switches, routers, and OLTs from different vendors
