

Safety Construction Plan for Optical Cable

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

All personnel must wear standard construction safety gear, including hard hats, steel-toed boots, high-visibility vests, and work gloves. Eye protection is mandatory when handling fiber optics to prevent injury from laser light or fiber shards. Disposable gloves are recommended when working with adhesives or chemicals used in splicing and installation .

Cable Handling and Installation Safety

- **Minimum Bending Radius:** Never bend cables below the specified minimum radius to avoid internal fiber breaks and signal loss. Typically, the bending radius should exceed 20 times the cable diameter .
- **Pulling Tension:** Do not exceed the cable's maximum pulling tension as specified in the manufacturer's datasheet to prevent damage .
- **Mechanical Protection:** Avoid sharp turns, edges, and excessive pressure on the cable sheath. Use figure-8 loops when coiling to prevent twisting .
- **Temperature Considerations:** Respect maximum installation and storage temperatures, especially for LSZH sheathed cables, which are sensitive to cracks un...
