- IEC 60439 / IEC 61439: These international standards specify requirements for low-voltage switchgear and controlgear assemblies, covering construction, electrical clearances, insulation, testing procedures, and system-level behaviors such as electric shock prevention, thermal endurance, short-circuit fortitude, and mechanical resilience .
- UL 508A: Common in North America, this standard applies to industrial control panels and distribution cabinets, focusing on component spacing, wiring practices, overcurrent protection, and enclosure construction .
- NEC (National Electrical Code): Provides minimum safety standards for electrical installations, including proper labeling, working space clearances, arc flash hazard analysis, and grounding requirements .
- OSHA / 29 CFR Part 1910 Subpart S: Covers electrical safety in workplaces, including design safety standards, safe work practices, and maintenance requirements for electrical systems .
