

Safety of fiber optic cable installation on highways



Article Overview

Fiber optic cable installation on highways is safe when proper handling, traffic management, and adherence to technical and regulatory standards are followed.

Worker and Public Safety

Safety is paramount during highway fiber optic installation. All personnel must wear personal protective equipment (PPE), including hard hats, safety glasses, gloves, and high-visibility clothing. Eye protection is especially important when handling fiber strands to prevent injury from shards or sparks during fusion splicing (). Work areas should be clearly marked with traffic cones, signs, and flashing lights, and a Traffic Management Plan (TMP) should be developed to protect both workers and the public ().

Cable Handling and Installation Precautions

Fiber optic cables are sensitive to bending, tension, and twisting. Exceeding the minimum bending radius or pulling tension can damage fibers internally, leading to signal loss or costly repairs (). Use swivel pulling grips and compatible lubricants to reduce stress during installation, and avoid coiling cables in continuous loops longer than recommended. For direct-buried installations, cables should be placed at proper depths with warning tapes to prevent accidental damage from future excavation ().
