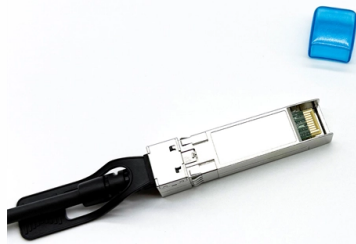


Should multiple switches be connected via Ethernet cable or fiber optic cable

Key Considerations

Distance and Speed: Fiber optic cables transmit data as light, allowing extremely high speeds over long distances with minimal signal loss. Single-mode fiber can exceed 10 kilometers, while multimode fiber is suitable for shorter intra-building runs . Ethernet cables, such as Cat6 or Cat6A, are ideal for distances under 100 meters and can support speeds up to 10 Gbps, making them sufficient for most office endpoints .

Interference and Reliability: Fiber is immune to electromagnetic interference (EMI) and is ideal in electrically noisy environments or where grounding issues exist . Copper Ethernet cables are susceptible to EMI, which can affect performance near heavy machinery or power lines .

Cost and Installation: Ethernet cables are generally cheaper, easier to install, and support Power over Ethernet (PoE) for devices like Wi-Fi access points, IP phones, and cameras . Fiber optic cables are more expensive, fragile, and require specialized tools and skills for termination and maintenance .
