

Should the pigtail and the cable connector be cut off



Overview

The pigtail conductor should be cut to a length that allows it to easily reach the device terminal without strain. Strip the insulation from the end of the pigtail and the existing circuit wires to the length specified by the wire nut manufacturer, usually about one-half to. Before beginning any electrical work, shut off the power at the main breaker. Confirm the circuit is dead using a non-contact voltage tester or a multimeter. Safety equipment, including safety glasses and insulated gloves, should be worn throughout the process.
