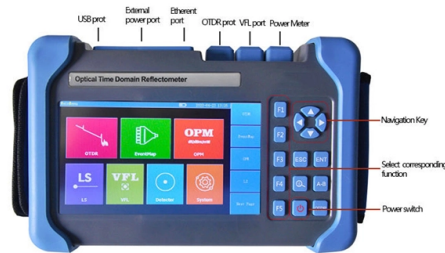


Single-mode fiber optic to DP communication interface



Article Overview

DisplayPort signals can be transmitted over single-mode fiber using active fiber optic extenders or converters, enabling long-distance, high-bandwidth video and audio transmission.

Overview

Single-mode fiber optic cables are designed to carry a single light mode through a very small core (typically 8–10 microns), which minimizes signal attenuation and allows transmission over long distances, often exceeding 10 km with low loss. This makes them ideal for high-speed digital signals like DisplayPort, which require high bandwidth and signal integrity.

How DP Signals Are Transmitted Over Fiber

DisplayPort signals are electrical by default, transmitted over copper cables. To send a DP signal over single-mode fiber, the signal must be converted from electrical to optical using a DP-to-fiber transmitter. At the receiving end, a fiber-to-DP receiver converts the optical signal back to electrical DP for display devices. This setup is commonly referred to as a fiber optic DP extender.

Key Components

- **DP-to-Fiber Transmitter:** Converts the DP signal into optical pulses compatible with single-mode fiber. These devices often support DP 1.2, 1.4, or 2.0 standards, depen...
