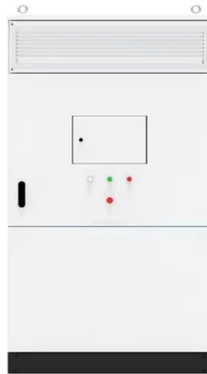


South Asia Optical Cable Construction

Overview of Optical Cable Infrastructure

Optical cables, particularly submarine communications cables, are laid on the seabed to connect countries and continents, carrying high-speed internet, telephone, and private data traffic. Modern cables use fiber-optic technology, typically about 25 mm in diameter and weighing around 1.4 tonnes per kilometer in deep-sea sections, with heavier cables near shorelines for protection . These cables are installed using specialized cable-laying ships and require careful planning to avoid hazards like fishing zones, shipping lanes, and geological obstacles .

Key Players and Companies

In South Asia, several regional and international companies are involved in cable laying and maintenance. For example, ASEAN Cables in Singapore operates dedicated cable-laying and repair vessels, and similar companies provide services across South and Southeast Asia . Global manufacturers like Alcatel Submarine Networks, SubCom, Prysmian, and NEC Corporation supply the cables and technology, while local operators manage landing stations and regional connectivity .
