

Specifications for use of cable tray supports



Article Overview

Cable tray supports are designed to provide mechanical stability, maintain proper spacing, and ensure safe routing of electrical cables, with specifications determined by load, span, material, and installation method.

Support Elements and Types

Cable tray supports include wall brackets, suspended supports, center suspensions, and trapeze hangers, which connect the tray to ceilings, walls, floors, or structural beams (OBO CMS), . Common support methods are:

- Trapeze hangers: Used for ceiling suspensions, supporting long runs of cable trays.
- Cantilever wall brackets: Mounted directly to walls for vertical or horizontal runs.
- Center suspensions: Provide support at midpoints for long spans to prevent sagging.

Material and Finish

Supports are typically made from steel, aluminum, or fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) depending on environmental conditions (ABB, Legrand), :

- Steel: High strength, suitable for heavy loads; may be galvanized or powder-coated for corrosion resistance.
- Aluminum: Lightweight, excellent corrosion resistance due to natural oxide layer....
