Fusion Splicing

Fusion splicing is the most reliable method for joining fibers. It involves:

- Stripping the protective coating from the fiber ends.
- Cleaning the bare fibers thoroughly.
- Precisely aligning the fiber cores using a fusion splicer.
- Using an electric arc to fuse the glass ends together, creating a continuous optical path.
- Protecting the joint with a heat-shrink sleeve to restore mechanical strength. Adv...
