

Standard Requirements for the Number of Distribution Boxes Installed



Article Overview

Typically, one distribution box or consumer unit is sufficient for a single residential premises, while larger or industrial buildings may require multiple distribution boards based on load and layout.

Residential Installations

For a standard residential property, one main distribution board or consumer unit is generally sufficient to manage all circuits, including the main meter connection, according to IEC 60364 and BS 7671 standards . The unit should be readily accessible, installed at a height between 1 meter and 1.8 meters, with 1.3 meters recommended for elderly or handicapped users . Adequate clearance around the panel is required for safe operation and maintenance.

Industrial and Commercial Installations

In industrial or large commercial buildings, multiple distribution boards may be necessary to handle higher electrical loads and to segment circuits for safety and efficiency . Each board should comply with IP/NEMA ratings suitable for the environment, and the installation must provide sufficient working space, typically 1.5 meters width, 1.2 meters height, and 0.5 meters depth for panels with IP54 protection . Modular designs are recommended to allow future expansion.
