

Standard Thickness for Cable Tray Machinery

Cable tray thickness varies by type, material, and duty class, typically ranging from 1.2 mm to 3.2 mm for steel and aluminum trays, with heavier-duty trays requiring thicker side rails.

Material and Duty Class Considerations

The thickness of cable trays is primarily determined by the load they must support, the type of tray, and the material used. Common materials include steel, stainless steel, and aluminum, each offering different strength and corrosion resistance characteristics .

- Steel trays: Standard thickness ranges from 1.5 mm to 3.2 mm, with hot-dip galvanized or pre-galvanized finishes providing additional corrosion protection .
- Aluminum trays: Typically 1.2 mm to 2.5 mm, chosen for lighter loads and environments where corrosion resistance is critical .
- Stainless steel trays: Often 1.5 mm to 3 mm, used in highly corrosive or marine environments .
