

Steps for twisting optical cable splice closures

Twisting optical cable splice closures involves careful cable preparation, sealing, grounding, and securing to ensure a reliable fiber connection.

1. Fiber Preparation

- **Remove the Cable Jacket:** Strip the outer jacket of the optical cable, including any shielding or armor, to expose the loose tubes. Leave approximately 3 meters of cable for handling and preparation .
- **Clean and Abrade:** Clean the loose tubes and strength member sheath using a suitable cleaning solution. Remove excess filling and abrade the outer jacket for about 150 mm to ensure proper adhesion of sealing materials .

2. Cable Installation in the Splice Closure

- **Select and Attach Sealing Rings:** Choose sealing rings that match the cable diameter and place them on the cable.
- **Insert the Cable:** Position the prepared cable into the designated entry port of the closure.
- **Grounding:** Connect and ground the cable's shield layer if present to prevent electrical interference .
- **Seal with Tape:** Wrap self-adhesive sealing tape between the sealing rings to create a tight seal and align with the outer diameter of the rings .
- **Secure the Cable:** Insert the sealed cable end into the closure and fasten it using...
