Straight sections are the long, linear lengths of cable tray that form the main pathways for routing and supporting cables.

Overview

Straight sections are the primary components of a cable tray system, providing a continuous path for cables and wires. They are designed to support, organize, and protect electrical and data cables in industrial, commercial, and data center applications ().

Standard Sizes and Materials

- Lengths: Common standard lengths include 5 feet (60 inches) and 10 feet (120 inches), with some manufacturers offering longer sections up to 40 feet for specialized installations ().
- Widths: Typical widths range from 4 inches to 12 inches for wire mesh or channel trays, and up to 48 inches for ladder-type trays ().
- Depths: Standard depths are usually around 2 inches for wire mesh trays, with ladder trays varying depending on rung spacing and cable load ().
- Materials: Steel (electro-zinc finished), aluminum, and stainless steel are commonly used, chosen based on strength, corrosion resistance, and environmental conditions ().
