The OTN layered architecture consists of sublayers including OPU, ODU, and OTU, each providing encapsulation, multiplexing, and transport management for client signals.

Overview of OTN Layers

The Optical Transport Network (OTN) is designed as a digital wrapper that standardizes the transport of multiple client signals (Ethernet, SONET/SDH, Fiber Channel, MPLS/IP) over optical fiber, ensuring high-capacity, low-latency, and error-protected transmission. The OTN architecture is organized into three main layers:

- Optical Channel (OCh) Layer – Represents the end-to-end optical connection, managing individual wavelengths in a DWDM system. It handles wavelength assignment, switching, and monitoring of optical signal quality using devices like ROADMs and optical wavelength switches.
- Optical Channel Transport Unit (OTU) Layer – Provides the digital wrapper for the OCh, adding forward error correction (FEC), frame alignment, and overhead for network management. The OTU ensures reliable transport across one or more optical channels.
- Optical Data Unit (ODU) Layer – Encapsulates client signals into OTN frames, providing path-level monitoring and management. The ODU layer supports multiplexing of lower-rate signals into higher-rate channels and includes overhead for tandem connection monitoring, automatic protection switching, and general communication channels
