Unlike access switches that connect end devices like PCs or cameras, aggregation switches consolidate traffic from multiple sources, reducing bottlenecks and ensuring smooth data flow across the network .

- **Redundancy and Reliability:** Many models include dual power supplies and non-blocking architectures to maintain uptime and prevent network failures .
- **Traffic Management:** Features such as QoS, ACL, IGMP Snooping, and Spanning Tree Protocol (STP) optimize traffic flow and enhance security.
