Article Overview

Switches with optical ports use fiber connections for high-speed, long-distance data transmission, often via SFP/SFP+ modules, and can coexist with Ethernet ports in hybrid models.

Types of Switch Ports

Optical Ports: These ports connect via fiber optic cables using optical modules such as SFP, SFP+, SFP28, or QSFP+ depending on speed requirements. They support high-speed data rates from 1G up to 100G+ and can transmit over distances ranging from hundreds of meters to over 100 kilometers, depending on the module and fiber type . Optical ports often use interfaces like LC, SC, or MPO and are ideal for core, aggregation, or high-performance computing networks .

Ethernet Ports: Standard RJ45 ports connect via copper cables (Cat5e, Cat6, Cat6A) and typically support speeds from 10M to 10G. Ethernet ports are limited to shorter distances, usually up to 100 meters, and are commonly used for access-layer connections to end devices .

Hybrid Switches

Some switches combine both optical and Ethernet ports, allowing flexibility in network design. Optical ports can also accept electrical port modules in certain cases, enabling copper connections through the same slot . This hybrid approach is useful when a network requires both long-distance fiber links and local copper connections.
