- **Bus Enclosures:** Designed for electrical distribution, these enclosures allow multiple circuits to be connected safely and efficiently.
- **Small Network Enclosures:** Ideal for home or small office racks, these 19" enclosures can house patch panels, switches, or terminal blocks, keeping network cabling organized and accessible .
- **Flanged or Non-Flanged Terminal Boxes:** These options provide flexibility in mounting and installation depending on space and rack configuration .
