A distribution box, or DB box, serves as the central hub for distributing electrical power from a single input source to multiple circuits within a building, ensuring safety and organized power management . The main components typically found inside a distribution box include: Circuit Breakers: These devices protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits by automatically cutting off power when a fault occurs . Fuses: Similar to circuit breakers, fuses provide overcurrent protection by melting when excessive current flows, preventing damage to wiring and appliances . Residual Current Circuit Breaker (RCCB): RCCBs detect small imbalances between live and neutral wires, offering additional protection against electric shocks . Isolators: Manual switches that allow sections of the circuit to be safely disconnected for maintenance or repairs . Bus Bars: Metal strips, usually copper or aluminum, that distribute electricity evenly to multiple circuits and serve as main connection points . Neutral Link and Grounding Bus Bar: The neutral link provides a return path for current, while the grounding bus bar safely directs excess current to the ground to prevent shocks and fires . Enclosure: The outer casing, made from durable materials like polycarbonate, ASA, or coated stainless steel, protects internal components from dust, moisture, and physical damage . Indication Lights: Visual indicators that show the status and availability of the main power supply . Surge Protective Devices and Smart Modules: Some modern DB boxes include surge protection, energy monitoring units, and communication modules for real-time monitoring and integration with home automation systems . These components work together to ensure that electricity is safely and efficiently distributed, prevent electrical faults, and allow ea...
