Function of Circuits in a Distribution Box

A distribution box, also called a DB box or panelboard, acts as the central hub for electricity in a building. It receives power from the main supply and distributes it to various circuits, which are individual pathways that deliver electricity to specific areas or appliances in a home, office, or industrial setting . Each circuit is designed to handle a certain load, ensuring that electrical devices operate safely and efficiently.

Key Components Related to Circuits

- Circuit Breakers (MCBs): Automatically cut off power to a circuit if the current exceeds safe levels, protecting wiring and devices from damage .
- Residual Current Devices (RCDs/RCCBs): Detect leakage currents and prevent electric shocks by disconnecting the circuit when necessary .
- Busbars: Metal strips that distribute electricity from the main switch to individual circuits, providing a reliable connection point .
- Main Switch: Controls the entire electrical supply to the distribution box, allowing all circuits to be disconnected during maintenance or emergencies .
- Neutral and Grounding Links: Ensure proper return paths for current and safely direct excess current to the ground during faults .
