Regulatory and Safety Standards

BS 7671 specifies that metallic distribution boards must have double insulation and covers for live parts, ensuring that users cannot touch energized components directly . NEC 250.148 requires that all metallic parts of the enclosure, including doors, be properly bonded to ground to prevent electrical hazards .
