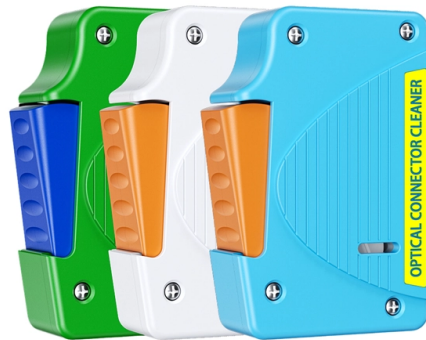


The fiber optic cable is not directly connected to the router

A fiber optic cable cannot connect directly to most routers; it typically requires an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or a compatible SFP port on the router.

Check Router Compatibility

Most standard routers do not have a direct fiber input. To connect fiber, your router must either have a fiber-ready WAN port or an SFP/SFP+ module slot. For example, Cisco 2911 routers require additional modules like HWIC-1GE-SFP combined with compatible SFP transceivers to enable fiber connectivity . If your router lacks these, it cannot accept a fiber cable directly.

Use an Optical Network Terminal (ONT)

Residential fiber connections usually require an ONT, which converts the optical signal into an electrical Ethernet signal that your router can interpret . The typical setup is:

- Fiber cable from the wall outlet connects to the ONT.
- Ethernet cable from the ONT connects to the router's WAN port.
- Power on both devices and wait for status lights to stabilize.
