This ensures that the tray can safely carry the total cable load, including future expansions . **Improved Airflow and Cooling:** Diagonal trays maintain the open design benefits of vertical cable trays, allowing heat to dissipate efficiently. This prevents overheating and prolongs cable life, especially in high-density installations . **Ease of Installation and Maintenance:** Diagonal trays provide better access for cable pulling and routing, making it easier to install new cables or perform maintenance without disturbing existing runs. This is particularly useful in multi-story buildings, data centers, and industrial facilities . **Compliance and Safety:** Diagonal transitions help maintain compliance with electrical codes by ensuring bend radii are within safe limits and reducing mechanical stress on cables, which is critical for both power and data systems
