The connector end plugs into equipment, patch panels, or optical distribution frames (ODFs), while the bare fiber end is fused or mechanically spliced to the incoming fiber, ensuring low insertion loss and high return loss for optimal signal transmission .

- **Mechanical Protection:** The steel wire shields the delicate optical fiber from physical damage caused by bending, crushing, or impact during installation and operation .
- **Tensile Strength:** It allows the pigtail to withstand pulling forces, which is especially important in outdoor, aerial, or industrial installations where cables may be subjected to tension .
- **Rodent and Environmental Resistance:** The steel layer prevents damage from rod...
