A non-solid (stranded or flexible) grounding wire is acceptable for home electrical systems as long as it meets code requirements and is properly connected.

Wire Types and Standards

Grounding wires, also called grounding conductors, can be solid or stranded and may be bare or insulated. Both forms are permitted under the National Electrical Code (NEC) and international standards, provided they are made of copper, aluminum, or copper-clad aluminum and meet the required gauge for the system . Solid bare copper is often preferred for cost efficiency and heat dissipation, but stranded wires are commonly used for flexibility and ease of installation, especially in tight spaces .

Safety and Function

The grounding wire provides a safe path for fault currents to flow into the earth, protecting people and equipment from electric shock and fire hazards . Whether solid or stranded, the wire must be securely connected to the grounding bar (PE bar) in the distribution box and to the grounding electrode, such as a rod or plate outside the home . Proper connection ensures that any fault current is safely diverted, preventing the panel or appliances from becoming live .
