

The optical power meter reading was zero

A zero reading on an optical power meter can result from reference calibration, connector issues, wavelength mismatch, or photodiode/electronics faults.

Common Causes

1. Reference Calibration: If the meter has been zeroed (reference set) without a proper light source or launch cord, it may display 0 dB or 0 dBm even when light is present. Always ensure the reference is established correctly using a clean reference patchcord and source before testing the fiber under measurement . 2. Connector Contamination: Dirty or damaged connectors can prevent light from reaching the photodiode, causing a zero reading. Clean all fiber endfaces and mating adapters with an appropriate fiber cleaner before measurement . 3. Wavelength Mismatch: Optical power meters are calibrated for specific wavelengths. If the meter's wavelength setting does not match the source, the reading may be inaccurate or zero. Verify that the meter is set to the same wavelength as the light source . 4. Photodiode or Internal Electronics Fault: A failed photodiode, damaged amplifier, or ADC malfunction can prevent the meter from detecting light. Symptoms include the meter powering on but never showing a reading. Testing the photodiode with a multimeter or replacing it may be necessary if other causes are ruled out . 5. Fiber or Source Issues: Ensure the light source is functioning and the fiber is not broken or disconnected. A true zero reading may indicate no optical signal is present in the fiber....
