If you need more ports and decide to connect two switches: Use the uplink port on one switch to connect to a normal port on the other. This connection helps to expand your network. The uplink port provides faster data transfers and helps manage increased network traffic. The uplink port on a network switch is usually a high-speed port on the switch, which is mainly used to connect equipment or The small local network is connected to a larger network, or connected to other high-speed devices in the topology (such as high-speed switches).
